

Côtes du Rhône Rosé

Grapes varieties:

Grenache	60 %
Carignan	10 %
Syrah	15 %
Cinsault	15 %

Yield: 50 hl / ha

Soil:

Limestone and clay

Age of the vines : 20 to 50 years.



Climate:

Mediterranean climate, characterized by a yearly pluviometry from 600 to 800 mm, Mistral blowing more than 100 days a year and summer dryness.

Vine growing:

The quality of each vintage is mostly representative of the wine-grower's yearly work. Therefore, we give special attention to the work on the vine during its growing cycle. For this purpose, we use integrated agriculture.

Vinification:

One can get rosé wines through the saignée method. Its color is obtained after some hours in maceration. Eventually, aromas are preserved thanks to a fermentation which temperature is highly controlled and never exceeding 18°C.
